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As you prepare your hearts and minds for the message today, I want to ask you a few questions to help you examine your spiritual life.

- 1) What does it mean to have grace and peace multiplied in our lives? (vs. 2)
- 2) How would you define “life and godliness”? What is the source? (vs. 3)
- 3) What are the “very great” and “precious” promises of God? (vs. 4)
Why are these promises important to consider when pursuing a redeemed life?
- 4) In vs. 5-7, which attribute is your greatest strength? Which attribute is your greatest weakness?
 - a. Faith – Moral Excellence – Knowledge – Self-control – Godliness – Perseverance – Brotherly affection - Love
- 5) Vs. 8-11: In what ways can you be more diligent and fruitful in your spiritual journey? Do you believe that you are living a redeemed life?
- 6) If today was your last day, would you have assurance that the Kingdom of heaven is richly prepared for you in Christ Jesus? Why or why not?
