God Confronts (3:8–13)

“The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.” (Luke 19:10)

“This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.” (Genesis 2:23)

“Let no one say when he is tempted, ‘I am being tempted by God,’ for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.” (James 1:13–15)

God Curses (3:14–19)

“What has a man from all the toil and striving of heart with which he toils beneath the sun? For all his days are full of sorrow, and his work is a vexation. Even in the night his heart does not rest. This also is vanity.” (Ecclesiastes 2:22–23)

“All go to one place. All are from the dust, and to dust all return.” (Ecclesiastes 3:20)

“Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned.” (Romans 5:12)

God Covers (3:20–21)

“Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it.” (Genesis 1:28)

“And they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loincloths.” (Genesis 3:7)

God Closes (3:22–24)

“Your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God.” (Isaiah 59:2)

“For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.” (1 Corinthians 15:21–22)

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3:16)
