## II. Relevance

A. Learning about the Law from the Old Testament

Two Great Commandments (Deut 6.5; Lev 19.18)

Ten Commandments (Exod 20; cf. Deut 5)

600+ laws (throughout remainder of Pentateuch)

- B. Living with the Law in the New Testament
  - 1. The Law is still in God's word (Matt 5.18; Jn 10.35; Rom 15.4; 2 Tim 3.16-17)
  - 2. Jesus said The Law still matters (Matt 5.17)
  - 3. Our relationship with God is supreme over every other relationship
  - 4. The Law stands as a constant reminder of our need for the gospel

## **III. Takeaway** 4 statements:

- 1. God still uses His word to free those who are in slavery to sin.
- 2. God still uses His word to declare His sovereignty.
- 3. God still uses His word to reveal His love for all who place their faith in His Son.
- 4. God still offers covenant promises & covenant expectations for those whom He saves.
