America is great; God's glory is greater

II. Living with a sure and certain hope in God's promises	
	1. We must resist the temptation to place our trust in national politics or government policies (1-3)
	2. We must remember our covenant with God is more significant than our rights under a constitution (4-5)
	3. We must lean on grace as we renounce sin (6-9)
	4. We must reserve our ultimate confidence for a sovereign God who will save His people (8-11)
	5. We must anchor our hope in God's reputation: His name will always be exalted on His earth (12-13)
