Fifth Word: Loving those who loved you first (Exodus 20.12; 08-02-20am)

Central Thought: We honor God by honoring our parents

I. Creating a culture of honoring parents

A. In the Home

Parents model honoring (Eph 6.1-4)

Parents teach honoring (Deut 6.4-7; cf. Prov 1.8-9)

B. In the Church

Nurture children by equipping parents

Encourage children by demonstrating dignity/respect for oldest members

Prepare children by serving as parents for the spiritually orphaned

C. In hearts and habits of children (Ex 21.15, 17; Deut 21.18-21)

Honor by respecting

Honor by caring

- 1) before they get old
- 2) after they get old

II. Honoring parents pleases God – the Promise

(cf. Deut 5.16)

God is looking out for you

God is looking in on you

God is looking to have a relationship with you

Concluding thoughts:

- 1. To honor parents is to honor God
- 2. Honoring parents does not begin or end when children leave the home
- 3. God wants His saints to care for those who can't care for themselves (1 Tim 5.3-4)
- 4. God is the only perfect parent
