## God's gift in Jesus: the liberating power of walking in the light (John 8.12-38; 05-16-21am)

Central thought: Following Jesus brings freedom over sin's power in this life.

## I. More truth about Jesus: the evidence of His claim is overwhelming (12-20)

- 1. Jesus is light that overcomes all darkness (12)
- 2. Jesus is the true judge in partnership with God (15-16)
- 3. Jesus is the Son of God, and the exact image of God (17-19)
- 4. Jesus is the revelation of God (19-20)

## II. The difference between followers of Jesus and those who oppose Jesus (21-30)

- A. A difference between life or death (21-24)
  - 1. Where Jesus goes, opposers cannot go (21)
  - 2. Jesus is from above (heaven), opposers from below (the world) (23)
  - 3. Believing in Jesus brings life; rejecting or opposing Jesus brings death (24)
- B. A difference between pleasing God or displeasing God (25-29)
  - 1. Jesus came to judge sinners (25-26)
  - 2. Jesus came to die on the cross (27-28)
  - 3. His death accomplishes the will of God (29)

## III. Jesus offers freedom, but faith must be genuine (31-37)

- A. Three characteristics of true disciples
  - 1. Abide in Jesus word (31) Abide: remain or reside; be near & stay near
  - 2. Recognize truth (32) Jesus is truth (Jn 14.6)
  - 3. Experience freedom from control of sin (32 & 36)

B. One reality about those whose faith is not genuine

The word of Jesus has no place in their life
