Pastors and members serving together: a partnership that pleases God (Heb 13.7, 17; 10-18-20)

Central Thought: A healthy church is reliant upon a cooperative, biblical, partnership, between pastors & members

I. Job One for Pastors: Care for the souls whom God has placed them over (17)

- A. Leader Duties: Watch over the flock *they are keeping watch over your souls*
 - 1. Relationship and intimacy engaged in the lives of church families
 - 2. Spiritual responsibility to care for the *souls* of church families (cf. Eph 4.11-14)

B. Leader Accountability: pastors will give an account for their ministry as those who will give an account

1. Immediate & present accountability to the congregation (Gal 1; 1 Tim 5)

Character expectations (1 Tim 3 & Titus 1) Shepherding expectations (1 Pet 5) Local church expectations (job description; bylaws; etc.)

2. Greater and higher accountability to the Lord (cf. Jas 3.1; 2 Tim 4.1-2) (also cf. Lk 12.48)

II. Job One for Members: Help the pastors care for your souls in a way that brings them joy (17, 7)

A. Member duties *obey your leaders & submit to them* two phrases with one intent

Obey: conveys the thought of being persuaded from Scripture – it has a positive tone Submit: conveys a willing attitude; yielding to the authority of those over you – with genuine respect

- 1. Faithful practices
 - a. Lean into Scripture (cf. Acts 17.10-12; Rom 12.2)
 - b. Learn your gifts and employ them for the good of the church (1 Cor 12.7; 1 Pet 4.10)

2. Following pastors
