Right thinking leads to right living which leads to experiencing the peace of God (Phil 4.8-9; 05-31-20)

Central thought: Godly living is the fruit of godly thinking

I. Think Rightly (8)

- A. Tie your thoughts to spiritual moorings whatever is
 - 1. The *whatevers* serve as spiritual moorings for how we should think
 - a. True: trustworthy; dependable
 - b. Honorable: noble; worthy of respect; uplifting (cf. Eph 4.29; 5.4)
 - c. Just: right; equitable (cf. Deut 32.35; Matt 7.12; 1 Pet 4.19)
 - d. Pure (moral context): chaste; undefiled (cf. 1 Pet 1.15; 1 Pet 5.8; Matt 5.27-28)
 - e. Lovely: pleasing; agreeable
 - f. Commendable: of good repute; of the highest standards
 - 2. The *ifs* in v8 are supplemental and inclusive *if there is any/anything*

excellence; worthy of praise serve as catch-all phrases; capture the spirit of right thinking

B. Focus your thoughts on virtuous living think about these things

We fight unhealthy and unholy thoughts by filling our mind with virtuous and holy thoughts

II. Live Rightly (9) practice these things

- A. Associate with godly models learned, received, heard and seen in me
 - 1. Another call to imitate a godly example (cf. 2.5-8; 2.19-30; 3.17)
 - 2. Imitation involves both instruction and observation learned and received heard and seen

Axiom: If you want to get better at something, spend time learning/imitating someone who is better

- B. Adopt godly methods (practices/behaviors) (cf. Matt 28.19-20) practice these things
 - 1. Godly methods are not automatically adopted or applied proven approach: use of spiritual disciplines (praying, reading Scripture, meditating on and memorizing Scripture, etc.)
 - 2. Good doctrine informs & equips good practices
- C. Apprehend godly peace God of peace will be with you

Close: Three implications & two applications

<u>Imply</u> 1. Christian life is a thinking life – ponder and consider godly characteristics

- 2. Christian life is also a practical life embrace and adopt what we see in models that God supplies
- 3. Christian life is a witnessing life godliness serves as a testimony to other saints & to the world

To the world, modeling virtues that are attractive (cf. Gal 5.23) becomes a witness for our faith In the church, modeling should be others-driven; touchable & doable – modeling should equip doing

<u>Apply</u>: two practical suggestions fall in category of putting off and putting on (cf. Eph 4.22-24)

- 1. Reduce your exposure to ungodly things make a list, pray about it & make some difficult choices List should include people (you hang with); programs (entertainment); practices (habits)
- 2. Increase your exposure to godly things make a list, pray about it & make some determined choices List include same categories
